For anyone new to our community, I want to share a little backstory for you. About 18 months ago, we realized that one of the things missing in our industry was a place for boutique photographers, where we could get together and be together and not focus on photography, because there are a ton of places to learn photography. But more importantly, learn how to run a profitable boutique business without going to a conference and sitting next to a person, who wants to spout out about how they only sell digital files and how Groupon is actually killing it for them. I wanted to have a place where you could sit next to a photographer, who has your same business model and the same dream to make money and put their family first. And how fun to get into a conversation with them about, how maybe you messed something up, the person next to you says, "Oh my gosh, I did that once too, keep going."

They don't ramble on and on about all the competition and, ooh, you shouldn't do that. And everybody just wants digital files and that's just not possible. Well, this past February, we hosted our first ever conference just for people like us, for boutique portrait photographers

who dream of something bigger. It was a smaller conference, but we had standing room only with about 300 seats in Dallas, Texas. And it was amazing. The energy was infectious. The community was full of camaraderie. And this may sound crazy, but it really was one of the favorite things in my life that I've ever done. Watching photographers come together, getting them to believe in themselves, having hope for their business, and leaving with an annual planner for the entire year, with tons of notes. A month later, COVID hit. Mid-year, as we started planning for 2021, we started looking at all of the options.

How can we have this conference? Should we have this conference? And the answer really became clear, that no, we can't safely deliver in person, Go Boutique Live, the way it was in 2020. There are too many unknowns, but we also didn't want to cancel the event. I know you need this now more than ever, because we have to navigate a new sort of normal. We want to be that rudder in the choppy waters. We want to be that strong voice that you listen to. The one helping you believe in yourself. The one providing new strategies to use during these uncertain times. The one who will be the bridge to a fabulous future. Just like I opened my first studio two weeks before 9/11, we can make our own economy, if we do certain things, right. And we will always be okay. So, my team and I sat down and we said, "How can we do this event virtually and make it as awesome as it was in person? And is that even possible?"

So, we dug in and we started researching, how we could make Go Boutique Live, an experience better than 2020. What we refused to do, was a pre-recorded event, where we have a bunch of speakers and they send in videos ahead of time. No, thank you. Why would anyone want to do that? We also didn't want to do simply a webinar Zoom call. We've had a lot of those and they're great, but this needs to be bigger. And sure, I could go live on Facebook. Those are great for challenges, but we want this to be an experience. So, we started attending every live virtual event that we could. And people were trying, but it just wasn't the same.

Finally, we attended a live virtual three-day event, that we had planned on attending in person. And, OMG, it was like nothing we'd ever experienced. The host had these huge screens all around her, where she could see all of us live on video. We were interacting with her in real

time, live in a way we wouldn't have been able to, even in person. So, that's where we were like, "Oh my gosh, this could even be cooler." We got a big box of swag that we opened before each program over the three days. So, it kept us on the edge of our seat, waiting for what was next. She was calling out our names constantly, interacting with us in live chat. We were going into breakout rooms. We couldn't even do that in person, because it would be too disruptive because, it would have stopped the flow of people on stage. And so, I don't know, I think this could be cooler and will be cooler than some of the things we do in person.

We could look at the lives of everyone on screen, in their homes, and they could look back at us. It was totally a different kind of engagement and intimacy. We were put in those smaller Zoom rooms, to work on things we were learning. Suddenly, we were pushing and encouraging each other, like a family, even though we'd only just met. So, here's what we did. Get this, we hired Tony Robbins' event team. Yeah. The people who took Tony Robbins' famous events with board breaking and fire walking, and brought that experience online. And we said, "Here's our challenge." And they said, "We can absolutely do it." So here we are, Go Boutique Live, get your pen and paper and write this down. It will be a three-day live virtual event, February 23rd, 24th and 25th, from early morning or whatever time zone you're in. Just plan on it, going from early morning till late at night. And you can adjust, when we get there.

But, last year we had so much going, we couldn't even get it in, in the two days. So, we're going three days instead of two. Listen, there will not be any recordings or replays. So, you've got to be there live. It's an experience. You can't watch a video of a party, or an event, or something that happened, and have it give you same result. Three days, full, long, awesome days, live and virtual. Here's the cool part. You don't have to travel. You don't have to leave home. But you do have to immerse. Just like you're leaving, get a sitter, go to the basement, go to grandma's, wherever, even make a closet if you need to. And give yourself a better 2021. We have tech limits and we have to produce swag boxes. So, the sooner you register the better. We can't guarantee the swag if you register late. And as you know, action takers are always rewarded. So, the sooner you take action, the better price you get.

Because, with in-person not being an option, I want you to put yourself in a bubble, of learning and inspiration, so that you can bring your best self into the world in 2021.
